Bengaluru: Chief Minister Siddaramaiah on Monday kicked off an elaborate Scheduled Caste (SC) census to determine the population across the 101 sub-castes and to assess their economic, educational and social backwardness as a precursor to introducing an internal quota.

ative on taking up an SC census follows the Congress-ruled Telangana's successful implementation of an internal quota for SCs, dividing them into three broad groups.

A large team of about 65,000 teachers will undertake door-to-door visits and hold special camps from May 19-21 to gather information. The government will open online registrations from May 19-23. The three-phase process will ensure effective gathering of the data, the CM said.

A commission headed by Justice H N Nagamohan Das will prepare the empirical data on the 101 castes

in the SC list. It will also end confusion over overlapping of communities in Adi Karnataka, Adi Andhra and Adi Dravida across the SC Left (Madiga) and SC Right (Holeyva).

The Justice Das Commission will give its report in two months, soon after which the government will implement the internal reservations, Siddaramaiah said.

The CM mentioned that the Supreme Court had ruled, in August 2024, that states could provide internal reservation within SCs, Scheduled Tribes and socially and educationally backward classes to remove inequalities.

# Ajit, Shinde Camps' Tensions Escalate Over Fund Diversion

NCP leader Mushrif slams Shiv Sena minister Shirsat for airing grievances publicly

Mumbai: The Nationalist Congress Party and the Shiv Sena, two allies in the BJP-led Mahayuti government, have gotten into a public tiff after Shiv Sena minister Sanjay Shirsat attacked the finance ministry, led by Ajit Pawar, for diverting funds from his department.

The NCP has not taken it well after Shirsat slammed the finance department for diverting funds allocated to his social justice ministry for payouts to the Ladki Bahin scheme.

"Where will Ajit dada bring money from? The sky? He is not taking the money home, the money is going that is being diverted for the Ladki bahin scheme. Calling names for a senior leader is not good," said Hasan Mushrif, senior NCP leader and state minister. The Ajit Pawar camp has claimed that the money being diverted from other accounts has nothing to do with the Shiv Sena but with financial constraints as the Ladki Bahin scheme, under which women in Maharashtra are being paid Rs 1,500 per month, is taking a huge toll on the state's exchequer.

Mushrif further said that Shirsat should have sat down with Ajit Pawar and sorted out the issue before going public with his grievances.

"The NCP is upset as Shirsat had on Saturday said that a 'Shakun' was involved in taking the decision to divert Rs 40 crore from his ministry for payouts to the Ladki Bahin scheme."

me. While Shirsat had not named Ajit Pawar, it was insinuated that his comments were aimed at the finance minister.

The Shiv Sena leadership's discomfiture with Ajit as the finance minister is an old grievance. In fact, when Eknath Shinde rebelled against the Uddhav Thackeray government along with his MLAs and joined hands with the BJP in 2022, Shinde and his Sena MLAs had claimed that they were frustrated due to Ajit Pawar not giving funds to their

ministries.

Even last month, another Shiv Sena minister Pratap Sarnaik, who is the transport minister, went public slamming the finance department for only paying him the salaries of the state transport employees.

Meanwhile, the Shinde camp is not trying to hide its displeasure with the Ajit camp as deputy chief minister Eknath Shinde skipped a felicitation function of former chief ministers of Maharashtra that was organised by the NCP this Saturday.

## GOVT FORMATION Sambit Patra Meets MLAs in Manipur

Guwahati: In what looks like the first moves towards government formation in Manipur, which is currently under President's rule, BJP's northeast in-charge Sambit Patra visited the state on Monday and held talks with leaders across the political spectrum.

Patra visited Churachandpur and met key leaders, including Thantlon MLA Vungzagin Valte, who survived a mob attack in Imphal in 2023. He also held meetings with Churachandpur MLA M Khaithe and leaders of the Zomi Students' Federation, who submitted a memorandum outlining their concerns.



SC says any freedom which facilitates such demeaning remarks need to be curtailed

New Delhi: Observing that hate speech cannot be misconstrued as a fundamental right, the Supreme Court Monday said it will curtail any kind of freedom, if it exists, which facilitates such demeaning remarks to demean any individual or community.

The development took place during the hearing of a plea alleging that stand-up comedians have made insensitive jokes mocking persons with disabilities. A division bench of justices Surya Kant and N K Viswas Singh issued notices to comedians Sunny Raina, Vipul Goyal and three others.

The bench also directed the Mumbai police commissioner to issue notice to them to ensure that they remain present in the court on the next date of hearing. The court made it clear that if the respondents (comedians) fail to appear, coercive steps will be taken against them.

Keeping in view the "sensitivity and importance" of the issue, the court also sought assistance of attorney general R Venkatesh in this regard. Appearing on behalf of the petitioner, senior advocate Aparajita Singh, submitted that since Raina and others are influencers, their



intentions raised, speaking for the bench, Justice Kant asked the petitioners to think of "remedial, curative and preventive" measures which can be adopted against such kinds of remarks.

"Unfortunately, there are people who, in the name of fundamental right of speech, keep on... continue to write articles as if everything is..." When Singh said that such kinds of insensitive jokes actually amount to "hate speech", Justice Kant responded, "Hate speech, any speech which is meant to demean another, this kind of freedom, if there, we will cur-

A division bench, comprising Justices BR Gavai and KV Viswanathan, posted the matter for resumed hearing next week. Notice has been issued to the Ministry of Home Affairs and YouTube.—OPB

## Petitions challenging Waqf Act to be Heard Next Week

Outgoing CJI Khanna sends petitions to bench headed by his successor Justice Gavai

New Delhi: Observing that the petitions challenging the recently passed Waqf (Amendment) Act would entail a detailed hearing, even for passing any interim directions, a three-member bench, headed by Chief Justice of India (CJI) Sanjay Khanna, on Monday listed the matter before a bench headed by Justice BR Gavai.

Khanna is to merit office on May 13 and the deed will be taken up by a bench headed by Khanna's successor, Justice BR Gavai, next week.

Passing the order, CJI Khanna said he does not wish to reserve any judgement or order even in the interim stage.

"We have gone through the counter and rejoinder. Yes, some points have been raised on registration and some figures are disputed by the petitioners. It needs to be dealt with. There are two things which we have to point out. I do not want to reserve any judgement or order even in the interim stage. This matter has to be heard on any reasonable day. It will not be before me," the bench, comprising Justices Khanna, PV Sanjay Kumar and KV Viswanathan, said.

In its response filed last month, the Centre had told the Supreme Court that the recently passed Waqf (Amendment) Act "by confining itself to non-essential practices, steers well clear of interfering upon the religious freedom guaranteed by the Constitution".

An affidavit was filed by the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) in response to the petitions challenging the Waqf (Amendment) Act. The Centre has submitted that the amendments to the Waqf Act were brought about after a comprehensive, in-depth, and analytical study conducted by a parliamentary panel.

# SC Panel Submits Fact-Finding Report on Judge Varma

Inquiry didn't include formal judicial steps but followed natural justice principles

New Delhi: A three-judge committee, constituted by Chief Justice of India Sanjay Khanna for a "deeper probe" into the allegations against Allahabad High Court judge, Justice Yashwant Varma, has submitted its fact-finding report to the CJI, said a statement released by the top court on Monday.

The committee, which comprised Punjab and Haryana High Court Chief Justice Sheel Naga, Himachal High Court Chief Justice GS Sandhawalia and Karnataka High Court Justice Anu Sivaraman had initiated its probe on March 25 and submitted its report dated May 2 to the CJI on May 4.

"The three-member committee consisting of Justice Sheel Naga, Chief Justice of the High Court of Punjab and Haryana; Justice GS Sandhawalia, Chief Justice of the High Court of Himachal Pradesh and Justice Anu Sivaraman, Judge of the High Court of Karnataka, constituted for conducting an inquiry into the allegations against Justice Yashwant Varma, a sitting judge, has submitted its report dated May 2 to the Chief Justice of India on May 4," the SC said.

ET had on March 26 reported that the three-judge committee will fast-track its probe. The committee has submitted its fact-finding report to the CJI after examining and cross-examining Justice Varma. The committee also examined the evidence and information made available to it, said people in the know.

As per the laid-down procedure, the probe being carried out by the committee is "not a formal judicial inquiry involving the examination and cross-examination of witnesses and representation by lawyers".

According to a leading Supreme Court judgement of 2015, the said committee "shall devise its own procedure consistent with the principles of natural justice". Previously, in an unprecedented move, the SC had decided to make public the "in-house inquiry" report prepared by Delhi High Court Chief Justice Devendra Upadhyaya on SC's website.

On March 25, the three-judge committee had visited Justice Varma's official residence in New Delhi. The trio had examined the room from where "4-5 sacks" of burnt currency notes were allegedly discovered on March 14 from the official residence of former Delhi HC Judge Varma.



## DENYING CHARGES

Justice Varma, who was transferred to the Allahabad HC, denied the accusations, calling them 'preposterous and unfounded'

Chief Justice of Delhi High Court Justice Devendra Kumar Upadhyaya, after completing his "in-house inquiry" into the unaccounted cash found in "4-5 sacks" at the official residence Justice Varma, concluded that the matter "warrants a deeper probe". Justice Varma was subsequently transferred to his parent high court — Allahabad High Court.

The CJI had ordered suspension of official work from Varma till the completion of the inquiry by the committee.

The CJI further in his correspondence with Delhi Chief Justice on March 21 had written that "Request letter may be sent to the Mobile Service Provider(s) for providing call record details of the official or other mobile phone number(s) of Justice Yashwant Varma for the last six months".

Also, the CJI had asked the Delhi Chief Justice to request Justice Yashwant Varma "to not dispose of his mobile phone(s) or delete or modify any conversation, messages or data from his mobile phone(s)".

Varma, in his written response to the Delhi Chief Justice on March 22, had called the accusations against him as "preposterous, incredulous and unfounded". Varma had written that "unequivocally that no cash was ever placed in that storeroom either by me or any of my family members" and strongly denounced "the suggestion that the alleged cash belonged to us".
